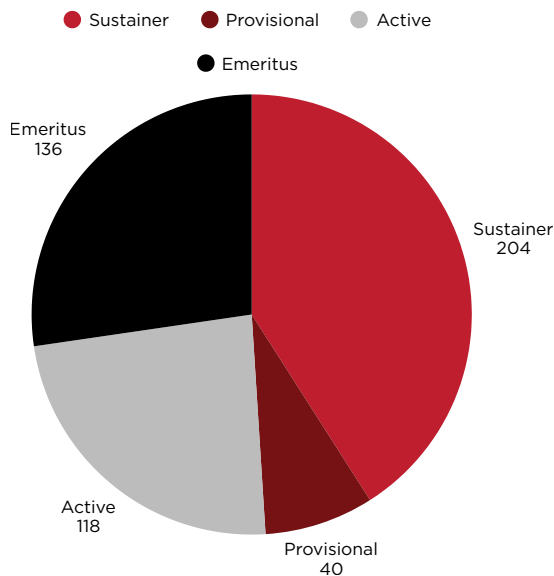
## Our Vision

Our members participate in trainings year-round to focus on professional and personal development. This allows our members that go on to serve on nonprofit boards and organizations to feel empowered as ethical and trained non-profit leaders.

- **Membership Events**  
We seek to provide special events or socials through our enrichments so that our members will appreciate to forge special and lasting connections.

- **Sustainer Events**  
More than 300 of our members are considered “Sustainers” who sustain the organization with their support, experience, knowledge. These women gather together for special events throughout the year.
